Uhing Will Not Exhibit on This Year's Wire

Uhing made the decision not to exhibit on Wire and Tube at Düsseldorf in December 2020 due to the current development of the Corona pandemic that is hard to foresee.

“Protecting the health and well-being of employees, customers and business partners has top priority for us, and finding it hard to foresee the general trend until December we regret having to cancel our participation in this year's Wire and Tube. This wasn't an easy decision because for us Wire and Tube have been major trade shows for decades,” explains Wolfgang Weber, Managing Director of Joachim Uhing GmbH & Co. KG.

Being an internationally operating company, the personal exchange with customers and business partners from all over the world is one of the most important reasons for Uhing to participate in the Wire. At present, it cannot be reliably foreseen that visiting the trade fair will be completely harmless to the health of employees and business partners. However, in the current situation, personal communication in particular is uncertain in the face of possible travel restrictions and the possibilities for face-to-face meetings while complying with a strict security concept and distance regulations are very limited.

Due to the pandemic, many efforts have been made to protect employees, customers and business partners through strict hygiene and safety measures and to ensure the continuation of production. For this reason, the Uhing managers are convinced that in this situation the cancellation is the only right thing to do to ensure the health and safety of all concerned.

Uhing will not stay away from Wire Düsseldorf permanently but is looking forward to future events and the continuation of the cooperation with Messe Düsseldorf.
